Referrals are received through CAF, however we also get referrals direct from the YPSEM (Young People at Risk of Sexual Exploitation and Missing) panel and offer support through Child in Need & Child Protection plans to do selected pieces of work with those individuals that are affected by CSE or SRE (Sex and Relationships issues). We offer two specific programmes (1-2-1 & Group work) one looking in to CSE and the other SRE (both prevention & support).
